Tuition and Fee Schedule Munnerlyn Campus



Tuition, Reservation Deposit, Payment Plans & Tuition Refund Insurance

A \$1,000 non-refundable reservation deposit applied toward tuition, plus a one-time facility fee of \$750 for all new students to the Munnerlyn Campus, are required upon enrollment. All accounts are due and payable upon receipt of the statement. Parents may elect to pay the tuition balance via any of the following payment plans.

*Tuition Refund Insurance (2.15% of 2021-2022 tuition) is optional and provides an opportunity to insure tuition (prepaid and due) in the event that a student withdraws during the school year. All families are strongly encouraged to take advantage of this program to ensure some tuition dollars can be recouped if a student has to withdraw unexpectedly for any reason.

Tuition

Episcopal offers an inclusive tuition model that minimizes extra costs during a student's time at ESJ and helps families budget effectively. In addition to the well-rounded experience across ESJ's Four Pillars of Academics, Arts, Athletics, and Spiritual Life, tuition includes: certain required academic software programs, PSAT testing, grade-level trips, lunch, parent organization fees, and admission to all school-sponsored dances.

Billing and Enrollment

- To be considered for reenrollment or financial assistance for succeeding academic years, the account(s) of a student and all of his/her siblings enrolled at the school must be considered current and the student must be in good academic and behavioral standing.
- If any payment is delinquent for 60 days following the due date, the student may be excluded from school attendance and activities.
- Incidental expenses are billed monthly, and tuition is billed according to the payment plan chosen. Parents/Guardians will select a Tuition Payment Plan and opt in or out of Tuition Refund Insurance via the enrollment contract. The school will continue to bill the selected options for the duration of the student's time at Episcopal, unless the family notifies the Business Office otherwise in writing.
- Students have charging privileges in the Campus Store at the discretion of parents/guardians, as long as their account is current.
- The school accepts cash, check, credit card, and wire transfers for payment of tuition and incidentals. Payments can be made online, through your bank's online bill pay, via U.S. Mail, or in person.

Additional Expenses

- Books Vary by grade level and course. Many books purchased at ESJ's Campus Store are eligible for 30-50% buy-back.
- Uniforms Provided by Mills Uniforms (available online and at the Campus Store); costs will vary by student.
- Technology Students are required to have a laptop or tablet computing device that meets the criteria established by the school.
- School Supplies Communicated by teachers on the first day of school for Upper School and during the summer for Middle School. Families are encouraged to purchase supplies through ESJ's Campus Store to receive pre-packaged discounts for Middle School supplies.
- Campus Store Charges billed monthly to student account.
- Extracurricular Activities/Trips Costs for extracurricular activities will vary greatly depending on the type and number of activities, travel required (outside of Jacksonville), etc.

Financial Aid

Need-based financial aid is available and, if awarded, is credited to the student's account in the same proportions as the tuition is billed. Financial aid applications must be submitted every year. Receipt of, and the amount of, financial aid in one year does not guarantee that same amount or any assistance in the future. For more information, visit esj.org/tuition.
